

Beginning on Monday, April 26, 2021, Duncannon Borough will be undergoing maintenance and repairs of various sewer lines.

Trinity Subsurface Engineering will be using high pressure water use to clean the lines, remove roots from the sewer lines, and then make point repairs.

Because of the high pressure needed to clear the sewer lines of debris, your home may experience water blowout from the trap of your toilets.

WE SUGGEST...

- That you keep the toilet seats DOWN at all times during this process for containment of any blowout.
- Place a large trash bag or tightly wrapped plastic wrap over your toilet bowl and lid in case pressure is released into your toilet. This will help to contain any toilet water backflow.
