March 5th - Come to the Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area as we learn about and observe the migration of thousands of Snow Geese and Tundra Swans at this important way station. Then hike an average paced 6 mile hike over moderate to strenuous terrain on a series of trails that form a loop back to the visitor's center. There are 2 climbs ranging from 300 to 400 ft. Meet at the at the Penn Dot parking lot at the Summerdale Mall (429 N. Enola RD, Enola) at 8:00am. (I will be driving a white Highlander.) Call 717-395-2462 or email dtakach@duncannonatc.org to register. Please reimburse drivers 10 cents per mile and for turnpike tolls (total mileage is 124 miles). Bring your cameras, binoculars and lunch.

April 9th - Join us for a 9 mile, average paced hike over moderate to strenuous terrain on the Pulpit Rock and Pinnacle Loop trail. We will be learning about Fishers which have been seen at Little Buffalo State Park. Meet at the Penn Dot parking lot at the Summerdale Mall (429 N. Enola RD, Enola) at 8:00am. (I will be driving a white Highlander.) Call 717-395-2462 or email dtakach@duncannonatc.org to register. Please reimburse drivers 10 cents per mile (total mileage 144). Pack a lunch.

May 21st - Hike 3 miles at an average pace over easy to moderate terrain at Wildwood Park as we check off animals and plants seen along the way on individual nature cards. The Susquenita Mountain Biking Team will be celebrating the 2nd year of participating in the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Cycling League (PICL) during the 2022 Fall season! Mountain biking is literally “cross-country” through rolling and sometimes rocky terrain and is different from BMX, downhill, or road cycling. We are now recruiting interested students. There are no try-outs, no sitting on the bench, and everyone participates. We will work on bike skills and fitness throughout the season, build confidence, go on adventures, and most importantly, have fun!

The team is open to all male and female students in the Susquenita School District, who are in grades 6-12 during the 2022-23 school year. Registration opens in April and practices will start in July, with a race season throughout the Fall. There will be smaller races locally and larger events across the state. Riders of all skill levels are welcome. Students do not have to race to join the team! They can participate in all practices, build their skills and confidence, help their team earn points by improving local trails, and participate in fun “Adventure Rides” at some events.

We will have an informational meeting for parents and kids on Wednesday, March 23, 2022 at 8:00pm. This will be via Google Meet, and you can connect by computer or call in by phone. At this meeting we will review how to register, what gear you will need, practice information, what happens at event weekends, fees, and answer any questions you may have before joining.

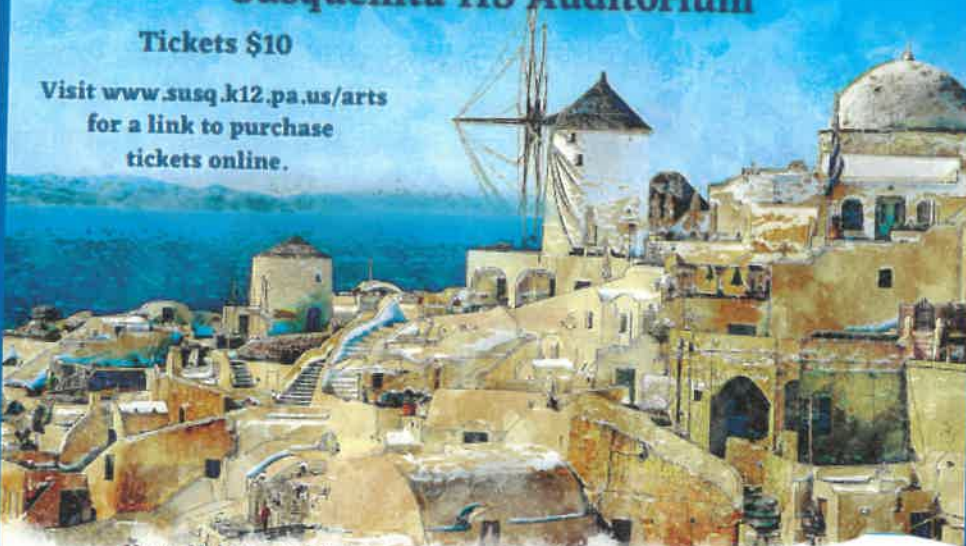

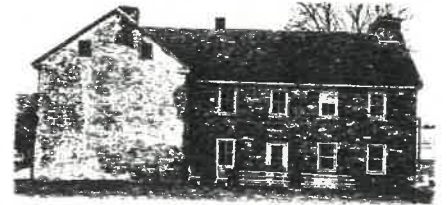
