**about Tax Collection  
Answered!**

- Paying multiple bills with one check is permitted.
- Receipts are only provided with a self-addressed stamped envelope or by paying in person.
- Incomplete/incorrect checks will be returned (due to possible postal issues, please check to make sure your check has cleared).
- In person payments are permitted during office hours listed on your bill or you may call for an appointment for a different day/time.
- Questions may be submitted via phone, text, or email.
- The tax office is in my home. Walk-ins or unscheduled payments are not permitted (unless during office hours). Payments may be placed in the mailbox at the front door.

-By law, real estate bills must be mailed to the property owner, even if taxes are paid via escrow. However, it is the owner's responsibility to make sure their bill is received by the mortgage company. (It is my experience that the mortgage companies request and receive the tax bill information from the collector or the county.)

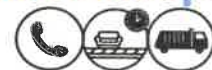

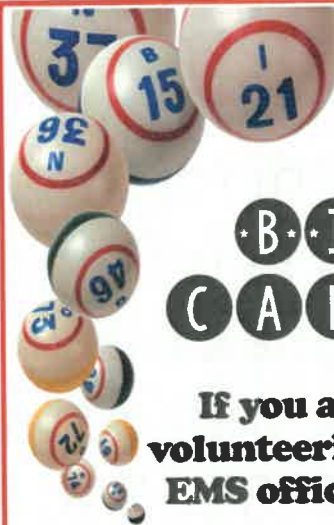

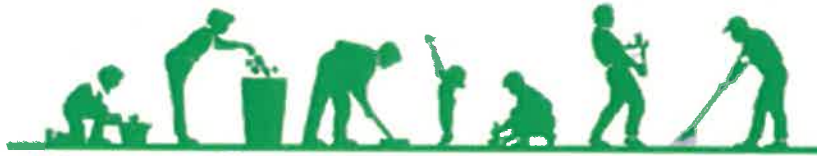
