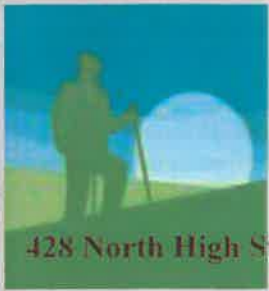

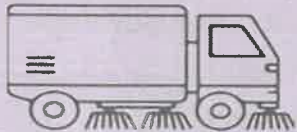

You will be asked for identification as proof of residency when dropping off recyclables.

The Boy Scouts will continue to offer curbside pickup at 8am in the Borough.

The following items can be placed together in a bag or box:

- Steel cans
- Aluminum (cat food, foil)
- Plastics (identified with #)
- Paper (junk mail, ads, etc.)

The following items must be separated:

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Newspapers - tied or in paper bags
- Cardboard

All recyclables should be clean and all containers should be crushed.

The following items will NOT be accepted:

- Glass, Books, Electronics,
- Batteries, Light Bulbs, Styrofoam,
- Other metal, Dirty items,
- Non-Recyclable Items.

The Duncannon Borough will sponsor a FREE Clean-Up Day for Borough Refuse Customers. It will take place at the Municipal Parking Lot between Blue Ridge Cable and Wheeler Field. Anyone wishing to take part in Spring Clean-up must bring valid ID or a 2024 utility bill stub to confirm their status as a Borough Customer.

All loose items must be bagged or bundled at a maximum of 40 lbs. per bag/bundle.

Accepted Items: Tires (Limit 2 per household), household items, toys, clothes, scrap metal, general yard, attic & basement clutter, mattresses and box springs, carpet & padding, furniture, appliances without refrigerants, car rims, & paint cans will be accepted if the paint is dried out or dried with cat litter. If you have items you are not sure will be accepted, please call the Borough Office and ask! You can reach us at 717-834-4311.
