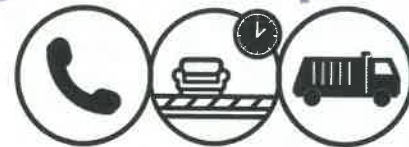

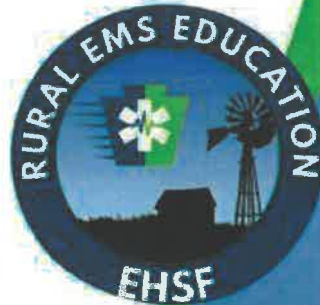

Paper (junk mail, ads, etc.)

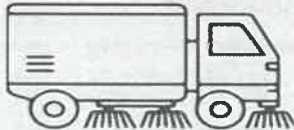
